BELT AND ROAD INITIATIVE FORUM Second (2nd) Session on Thursday 23rd August 2018

This is a forum of a series of four bimonthly sessions with a theme of "Belt and Road Initiative" (BRI), which is jointly organized by The Hong Kong Logistics Management Staff Association (HKLMSA), C.Y. Tung International Centre for Maritime Studies, PolyU (ICMS) and the Hong Kong Seamen Union (HKSU). It employs the Interdisciplinary Learning/Back-to-Basics (IDL/B2B) methodology and the sessions are conducted in an open forum case study with interactive question and answer (Q&A) discussions. It is a platform for those from all sectors of the Hong Kong economy, businessmen, eminent professionals, academics and even students, to explore what BRI offers them, and to share their expertise and valuable experience in realizing the opportunities through application of the BRI Triangle Theory of "Politics, Economics & Culture".

The Second (2nd) Session of the BRI Forum is on the topic "Logistics Development in Hong Kong – Challenges & Future under BRI".

It will examine the development of logistics in Hong Kong mainly from 1950, in maritime, land and air transportation, in an integrated logistics system, with main focus on maritime and aviation industries. It will trace the development of Hong Kong as a transshipment port, its development into a container port from the 1970's, and the growth of the aviation sector. There will be case study discussions on the possible impact of the HK/Macau/Zhuhai Bridge and the Greater Bay Area Development to HK logistics, in relation to its current problems and issues.

The Moderator for this 2nd Session will be Mr. Sunny Ho Lap Kee of the Hong Kong Shippers' Council, with other members of the Panel of Moderators and Advisors in attendance.
